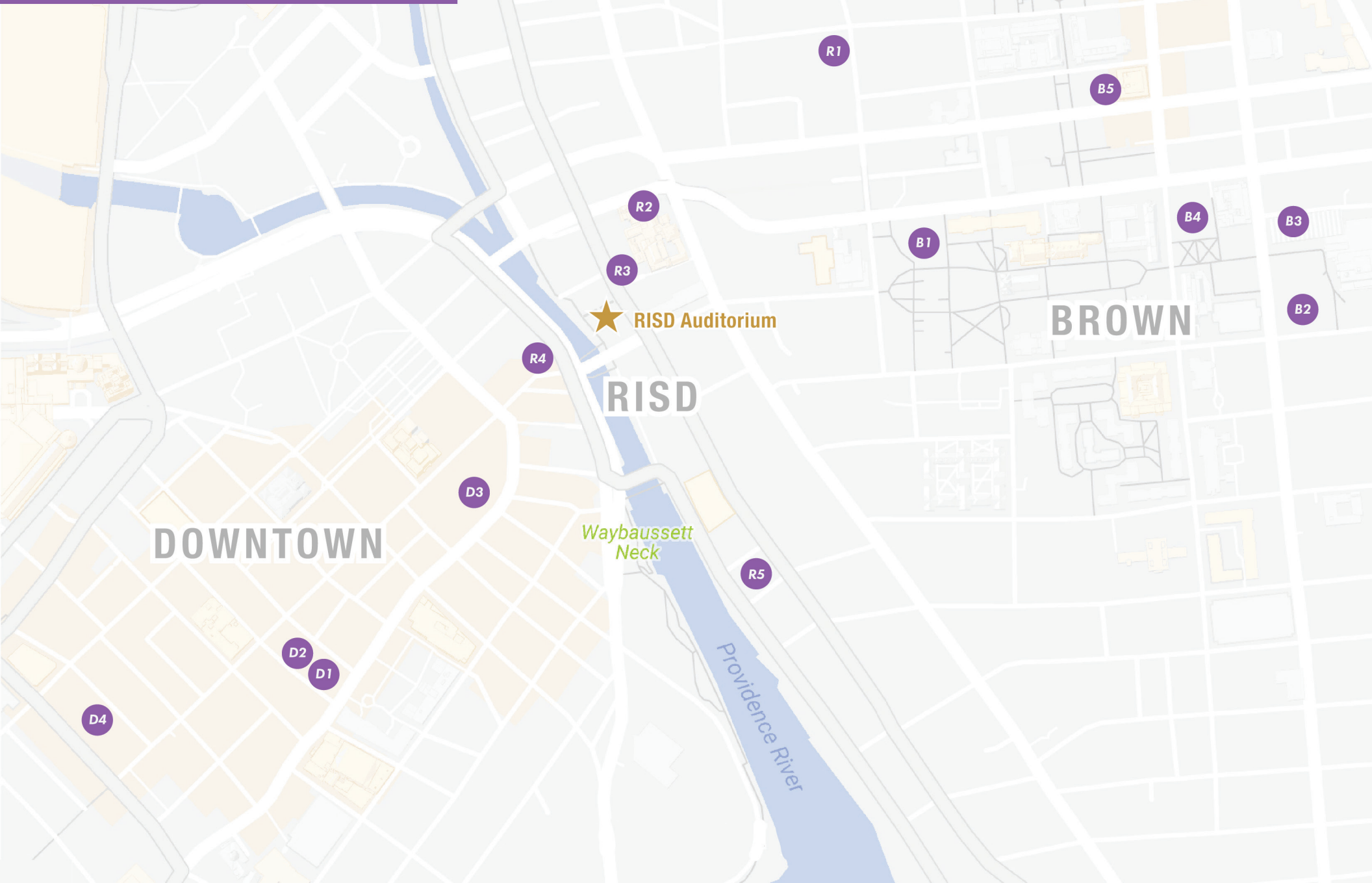

### D2 RISD Coworks

211 Union Street

Outfitted with some of RISD's state of the art technology, this is where you'll find the art nerds at play.

### D3 The Arcade

130 Westminster Street

Built in the 1820s, the Greek Revival Arcade is known as the oldest indoor shopping mall in the country.

### D4 AS220 Arts Collective

115 Empire Street

AS220 is an artist-run organization committed to providing an unjuried and uncensored forum for the arts.

### D5 The Design Office

204 Westminster Street, 3F

The Design Office is a shared workspace for designers in downtown Providence, R.I.

### R1 Woods-Gerry

62 Prospect Street

Admissions office at RISD. The gallery space currently features the Industrial Design Senior Show.

### R2 Nature Lab

13 Waterman Street

The lab offers unmediated access to authentic natural history specimens, from nearly nano-scale to life-sized objects — such as taxidermy, skeletons, and bacteria.

### R3 Metcalf Building

7 North Main Street

One of the Fine Arts building. It houses the Glass, Jewelry, Sculpture, Furniture, Ceramics, and Textiles departments.

### R4 Fleet Library

15 Westminster Street

Library collections include more than 155,000 volumes and 320 periodical subscriptions (print).

### R5 Industrial Design Building

161 South Main Street

Visit the ID building to see how creativity spurs in the woodshop, metal shop, model shop, open studio spaces.
